The English noun *Sunday* derived sometime before 1250 from *sunedai*, which itself developed from <u>Old English</u> (before 700) *Sunnandæg* (literally meaning "<u>sun</u>'s day"), which is cognate to other <u>Germanic languages</u>, including <u>Old Frisian</u> *sunnandei*, <u>Old Saxon</u> *sunnundag*,

Dominica (Latin), the Day of God. The Romance languages, languages derived from

### Christ's Day Of Worship According to the Bible

Luke 4:14-17 { And Christ returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about. And he taught in their synagogues being glorified of all. And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as was his custom, he went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up for to read. And there was delivered unto him the book of Esaias (Greek for Isaiah), And when he had opened the book, he found the place where it was written....} Custom is something that a person has done all their life, as in a tradition. Therefore, according the Luke, everyday of Christ's life he celebrated and observed the Sabbath Day (7th Day), no Sunday.

**Biblical Places Where People Actually Worshipped the Sun** (Real Sunday Worship). The Sun Rises in the East, keep this in mind.

2nd Kings 23:5- .... They worshipped the Sun Ezekiel 8:16-... they worshipped the Sun Jeremiah 8:2- ... they worshipped the Sun Who Changed The Day of Worship From the Sabbath Day to a Sunday (Sun's Day), It Wasn't GOD or Christ, it was Constantine (A Man)

"On the Venerable Day of the Sun I"venerabili die Solis"--the sacred day of the Sun] let the magistrates and people residing in cities rest, and let all workshops be closed. In the country, however, persons engaged in agriculture may freely and lawfully continue their pursuits; because it often happens that another day is not so suitable for grainsowing or for vine-planting; lest by neglecting the proper moment for such operations the bounty of heaven should be lost--Given the 7th day of March. [A.D. 321], Crispus and Constantine being consuls each of them for the second time." The First Sunday Law of Constantine 1, in "Codex Justinianus," lib. 3, tit. 12, 3; trans. in Phillip Schaff "History of the Christian Church," Vol. 3, p. 380.

"Christians shall not Judaize and be idle on Saturday [in the original: "sabbato" shall not be idle on the Sabbath], but shall work on that day; but the Lord's day they shall especially honour, and as being Christians, shall, if possible, do no work on that day. If, however, they are found Judaizing, they shall be shut out ["anathema,"--excommunicated] from Christ." Council of Laodicea, c. A.D. 337, Canon 29, quoted in C.J. Hefele, "A History of the Councils of the Church," Vol. 2, p. 316.

### What is the Sabbath Day

#### Sabbath and Creation:

No matter your religion, no story tells it better than Genesis.
